What we can do for you

3D Design Service

As part of our service and initial visit we will take some details which enables us to build 3D designs of your preferred conservatory.

We find this really helps our customers to visualise the living space and to consider the impact it may have on their home.

Working with our designer you can alter the colour, design options, size and various details such as building work, visualising the difference between dwarf walls or having full height glass.






Cheltenham








Edwardian




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York

It also enables the creation of a vaulted or pitched ceiling that provides a feeling of height to the room, while the gable end of the structure allows for maximum light ingress. The structure will be fully bespoke and we can offer a range of minimalist concepts up to a range of more ornate and decorative designs for both the main body and the gable end to provide you with a styling that perfectly enhances your home.











Victorian 3 facet

Victorian 5 facet

If you are blessed with these panoramic views, this would definitely enhance your new living space.

Livinroof

Wouldn't it be wonderful if you had the flexibility to combine solid and glazed roofing seamlessly? By choosing a Livinroof as part of your new conservatory, you can do just that!

The Livinroof roofing system, is constructed from insulated composite external panels and high performance PU board insulation. These are strong and robust, and extremely thermally efficient.

Livinroof can incorporate glazed panels that allow daylight to flood in. They can be inserted to replace almost any of the roofing panels. This lets you maximise light and produce a contemporary feel that is not easily achievable with other types of

roofing system.

You could opt for a magnificent vaulted ceiling, which allows you to insert or hang lights along the ridge at the top. There's a perimeter ceiling system too, ideal for spotlights and speakers, which also gives the effect of lifting the ceiling.

Tiled Roof Extensions

If you want something that feels more substantial than a glass roof conservatory, but still provides copious amounts of natural light, then our tiled roof extensions are the perfect solution.

They are specially engineered to maximise the amount of glass, but still have the strength and stability built in to support a tiled roof.

The roof is engineered and manufactured offsite to enable quality control and minimise disruption to your home, then assembled onsite. The sturdy insulated roof panels give superior thermal performance and complies with all current building regulations. With the added option of full height glass panels in the roof, you can let in natural light where required, creating the best of all possible worlds.

Inside, the effect is completed with a plastered vaulted ceiling with optional downlights creating valuable extra living space that you can use all year round.

Replacement Roofs
